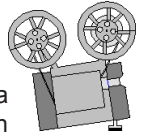

## THE BIG SCREEN MOVIE – Dudley Park - Saturday, August 20<sup>th</sup>

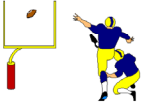

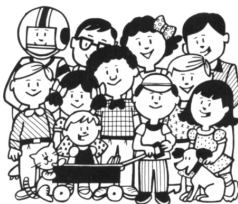
