

**ORDINANCE NO. 2019 - 9**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1365 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WILLOWICK, OHIO, TITLED, "LICENSING OF SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL RENTAL UNITS"; SPECIFICALLY, CODIFIED ORDINANCE 1365.03 "LICENSE APPLICATION; FEE," AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Willowick, County of Lake, and State of Ohio:

**Section 1.** That Chapter 1365 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willowick, Ohio, titled, "Licensing of Single-Family Residential Rental Units"; specifically, Codified Ordinance 1365.03 "License Application; Fee," is hereby amended to read and provide as follows:

**1365.03            LICENSE APPLICATION; FEE**

(a) An application for a license required by this chapter shall be in a form approved by Council and shall state the name and address of the applicant and the nature and extent of his or her interest in the single-family dwelling unit for which the license is desired. If the applicant is not the owner of such building, then the application shall also state the name and address of the owner. The application shall further state the location of the single-family dwelling unit for which the license is desired and the number of rooms therein, together with such other information as may be required by the Chief Building Inspector, and such application shall be accompanied with an application fee in the amount of three hundred dollars (\$300.00). The owner of the single-family dwelling unit shall re-apply for a license required by this chapter two years from ~~the date of~~ the initial inspection month.

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
**Section 2.** The existing Section 1365.03 of the City's Ordinances is hereby repealed in that said Section is superseded by this legislation.

**Section 3.** All formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting, and that all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, welfare and dignity of the residents of the City of Willowick.

**WHEREFORE,** this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.


