

ORDINANCE NO. 2019 - 18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 747 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WILLOWICK, OHIO, TITLED "VENDORS FROM VEHICLES"; SPECIFICALLY, AMENDING SECTION 747.01, TITLED "VENDING PROHIBITED," AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOWICK, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

**Section 1.** Chapter 747 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willowick, Ohio titled "VENDORS FROM VEHICLES"; specifically, Section 747.01 "VENDING PROHIBITED" is hereby amended to read and provide as follows:

747.01 ~~VENDING PROHIBITED.~~ **VENDING PERMIT REQUIRED.**

**No person shall sell, offer for sale, or solicit the purchase of any goods, wares, merchandise or other articles of value, including food, candy, confections, frozen desserts, and beverages from a vehicle traveling within the City.**

No person shall sell ~~or~~, offer for sale, ~~or travel about the City~~ soliciting the purchase of any goods, wares, merchandise or other articles of value, including food, candy, confections, frozen desserts ~~and or~~ beverages, ~~when~~ **unless** such activities are conducted from a **stationary** vehicle **whose operator has been issued a Vehicle Vendor Permit by the Chief Housing and Zoning Inspector. A Vehicle Vending Permit application shall be submitted to the Chief Housing and Zoning Inspector and accompanied by a \$75.00 application fee.**

**Section 2.** The existing Section 747.01 of the City's Codified Ordinances is hereby repealed in that said Section and is superseded by this legislation.

**Section 3.** All formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting, and that all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, welfare and dignity of the residents of the City of Willowick and therefore shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage by Council and its approval by the Mayor, or at the earliest period allowed by law.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
