

**ORDINANCE NO. 2020 - 6**

**AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF SEAN BRENNAN TO THE POSITION AS CHIEF HOUSING AND ZONING INSPECTOR, PROVIDING FOR THE INSPECTOR'S COMPENSATION, REPEALING CERTAIN ORDINANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the confirmation by Council of the mayoral appointment to the position of Chief Housing and Zoning Inspector is required pursuant to Codified Ordinance 1331.021.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOWICK, COUNTY OF LAKE, AND STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That the Council hereby confirms the mayoral appointment of Sean Brennan to the position of Chief Housing and Zoning Inspector for the term commencing January 1, 2020 and terminating December 31, 2023, is hereby approved and confirmed.

**Section 2.** That Sean Brennan, as Chief Housing and Zoning Inspector shall be paid compensation at the rate of Two Thousand Seven Hundred Forty-six and 42/100 Dollars (\$2,746.42), per bi-weekly pay period.

**Section 3.** That the Chief Housing and Zoning Inspector shall respond to the inquiry of Council regarding the services which he shall perform and such matters that would come within his responsibilities.


**Section 4.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such actions were conducted in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 123 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willowick.

**Section 5.** That all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


**Section 6.** This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willowick; and for the further reason to ensure the timely and uninterrupted operation and performance of the City's Building and Zoning Departments;

**WHEREFORE**, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approved by the Mayor.
