

ORDINANCE NO. 2020 - 11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 155 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WILLOWICK, OHIO, TITLED "EMPLOYEES GENERALLY"; SPECIFICALLY, AMENDING SECTION 155.02.1, TITLED "CONTINUOUS FULL-TIME SERVICE," AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOWICK, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. Chapter 155 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willowick, Ohio titled "EMPLOYEES GENERALLY;" specifically, Section 155.02.1 "Continuous Full-Time Service" is hereby amended to read and provide as follows:

(a) Full-time, non-bargaining employees shall be granted additional compensation based upon years of continuous full-time employment with the City of Willowick (excluding the Executive Lieutenant of the Police Department who is covered under a separate section of these Ordinances). Such compensation shall be annualized and added to salaried employees' compensation based upon the schedule set out below:

YEARS OF CONTINUOUS FULL-TIME SERVICE WITH THE CITY OF WILLOWICK

After completing five (5) full years	\$.20 0.24 hr. (\$416.00 annual)
After completing ten (10) full years	\$.25 0.48 hr (\$520.00 annual)
After completing fifteen (15) full years	\$.30 0.72 hr (\$614.00 annual)
After completing twenty (20) full years	\$.35 0.96 hr. (\$728.00 annual)

(b) There shall not be considered to be a break in continuous full time employment in the case where a retirant becomes re-employed pursuant to the provisions of Ohio R.C. 145.381

Section 2. The existing Section 155.02.1 of the City's Codified Ordinances is hereby repealed in that said Section and is superseded by this legislation.

Section 3. All formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting, and that all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, welfare and dignity of the residents of the City of Willowick and therefore shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage by Council and its approval by the Mayor, or at the earliest period allowed by law.


WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
