

ORDINANCE NO. 2016 - 31

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2016-15 TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE GENERAL FUND (101); POLICE AND FIRE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND (207); HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT FUND (223); FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF WILLOWICK, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2016, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

That this Ordinance is hereby declared and determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of said City for the reason that immediate provision must be made for the appropriation herein provided for and it shall, therefore, be in effect immediately upon its approval by the Mayor of the City.
