Trash areas clean and garbage stored in cans with lids		
Wood and building materials stacked 18 inches off ground and away from the foundation to prevent rodent habitation		
Foundation areas free of clutter/trash that might attract rodents		
Dog droppings removed from yard frequently		
Bird feeders maintained to prevent spillage of seed or food		
Pet food stored indoors in sealed rodent-proof containers		
No ground feeding (bread, nuts, corn, etc.) of wild animals		
Grass is cut and bushes trimmed		
Composting properly (no dairy, meat or fat)		
Fallen fruits and vegetables (from trees and gardens) are promptly removed		
Water sources eliminated (turn over buckets, empty birdbaths, etc.)		
Eliminate nesting materials (store lawn chair cushions and other fabrics in rodent-proof containers when not in use)
