ORDINANCE NO. 2024-25

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION OF PART-TIME POLICE OFFICER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the police department has a need for part-time police officers to perform certain duties in the police department; and

WHEREAS, the said part-time employees' compensation is not governed by the terms of a collective bargaining agreement.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOWICK, LAKE COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That effective with the first full pay period in March 2023, part-time police officers in the Willowick Police Department, whose compensation is not otherwise governed by a Collective Bargaining Agreement, shall receive compensation at a rate of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00), per hour.

SECTION 2: That all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent inconsistent herewith.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willowick and further, provides for the usual daily operation of a municipal department and its police forces; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
