Reminder- In order to participate/purchase any recreation programs, pool pass, swim lessons, etc. a Willowick Recreation Tag is required for each participant; Resident Fee: \$15, Non-Resident Fee: \$20, and \$10 Annual Renewal Fee on all Recreation Tags.

Debit/ Credit Card payments will charge a 2.5% Transaction Fee

Proof of Residency Required: In order to receive Resident Rates on any of our programs, swim passes, swim lessons, summer camp, facility rentals, etc., proof of residency is required. Acceptable proof of residency is a current utility bill with your name and address on it along with your photo I.D. Attention Parents/Guardians, if your minor child has a different last name than yours, you must provide their birth certificate or court documents showing guardianship.

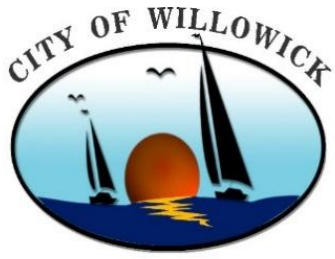

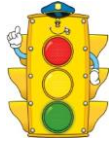
Jazzercise

Willowick Summer Day Camp



June 8th to August 7th

Willowick Summer Day Camp is a nine-week, theme-based program for children ages 5–12. Children must be 5 years old by June 1 to participate. Campers are grouped by age: 5–6, 7–8, and 9–12 years old.

Camp runs Monday–Friday, 7:30am–4:30pm (*no camp Friday, July 3*). The camp fee includes a Camp/Swim Pass (valid at both city pools), a camp T-shirt, field trips, and crafts & supplies. Campers must bring a packed lunch, swimsuit, towel, tennis shoes, and socks daily. Campers may bring a small amount of money for concession snacks. Learn-to-Swim lessons are available during the 9:00am session for an additional fee.

Camp is staffed by qualified teachers and college students pursuing careers in education, providing a safe, engaging environment where children can learn and play.

Emergency contact information, physician details, and medical information are required at the time of registration. **Registration begins Tuesday, February 24.**

Rookie Sports T-Ball (Ages 3-4) 6:00-6:45pm Fee: \$80

This T-Ball program is a great introduction to the game of baseball for young children.
