Hello and welcome, we are extremely excited to be your new service provider. We are confident in the potential for a successful, long-term, relationship with you and the City of Willowick. Our team wanted to touch base with a few things prior to our first pickup, which will commence on 2/3/2025.

To ensure efficient service, please have all items to the curb by 6AM on your scheduled service day. We've coordinated with the city and Kimble, and your collection days will remain unchanged. To prepare for your upcoming service(s), we have started delivering your carts to your residence. This early delivery allows us to address any potential issues before the service begins. Your patience is appreciated as we undertake the significant task of delivering approximately 11,000 carts to city residents. We kindly ask that should any questions arise feel free to contact us at (440)254-4929 or info@majorwastedisposal.com. Our operations manager will be in the city throughout this process to address any urgent issues. If you have not yet contacted us to choose your preferred level of service, we have defaulted you to the FULL-SERVICE option. Please contact us to adjust your services if needed.

You can expect to receive your first quarter bill on February 3rd.

For the safety of our employees, all bulk items that exceed the size of the cart (e.g., furniture, mattresses and all other cloth-like-items) must be securely wrapped in plastic. Refrigerators, freezers, and window air conditioning units must be properly drained of fluids and tagged by a service technician for safety reasons. We kindly request that you contact our office in advance to inform us of any bulk item disposals. This will allow us to ensure that proper handling instructions are communicated to our team.

The back side of this letter provides a RECYCLE RIGHT guide, outlining acceptable vs unacceptable items for your bin. Our drivers will be monitoring bins for contamination. If a recycle bin has unacceptable items, it will be tagged with a blue cart hanger indicating the contamination. There are instructions on the tag as to what items could have been placed in the wrong bin. We transport all collected recycling to an approved sorting facility for recovery and reuse. We strive to ensure the highest quality of recyclable materials to support a sustainable recycling program.
