Pat Mahorcic, thought by going the Honorary way, would be the way go. Scott Skrjanc 488 E. 321st Suggested to name the cut thru between E. 321st & Vine St, the avenue to take. The only way that could happen was by St. Mary Magdalene adding that since it is not a municipal street.

At the 14:59 moment of the meeting I suggested to my committee member Patrick Mohorcic, we should suggest to Council @ our next Council Meeting his idea of keeping it E. 321st and adding Jim and Mary Lou Beers Way.

Our Law Director Stephanie Langraph asked since we are in discussion on this topic, to add parameters on someone suggesting in the future renaming of a street. Some of those suggestions would be the honoree must of been a resident of the City, made a significant

contribution to the community ,arts,science, or religion.The honorary sign will be different in color and be incorporated into the original sign. The application for honorary designation would be the consent of at least seventy percent of the property owners of the street.

Where an honorary street sign is installed, the original name of the street and postal addresses wil remain the same.

Our Mayor said Todd Shannon's Department would start working on the sign.
